Nagoya Purple Kale Brassica oleracea var. acephala 'Nagoya Purple'

Height: 12 inches

Spread: 15 inches

Description:

This ornamental variety produces a beautiful dense rosette of ruffled purple foliage, framed by gray-green mature leaves; a stunning garden accent, or may be used as a container focal point; color is dependent on cool weather

Ornamental Features

Nagoya Purple Kale is primarily valued in the garden for its ornamental globe-shaped form. Its attractive crinkled round leaves remain purple in color with distinctive pink veins and tinges of gravish green throughout the season.

Landscape Attributes

Nagoya Purple Kale is a dense herbaceous annual with a more or less rounded form. Its medium texture blends into the garden, but can always be balanced by a couple of finer or coarser plants for an effective composition.

This plant will require occasional maintenance and upkeep, and should not require much pruning, except when necessary, such as to remove dieback. It has no significant negative characteristics.

Nagoya Purple Kale is recommended for the following landscape applications;

- Accent
- Mass Planting
- General Garden Use
- Container Planting

Planting & Growing

Nagoya Purple Kale will grow to be about 12 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 15 inches. This fast-growing annual will normally live for one full growing season, needing replacement the following year.

This plant should only be grown in full sunlight. It requires an evenly moist well-drained soil for optimal growth, but will die in standing water. It may require supplemental watering during periods of drought or extended heat. It is not particular as to soil pH, but grows best in rich soils. It is somewhat tolerant of urban pollution. Consider applying a thick mulch around the root zone over the growing season to conserve soil moisture. This is a selected variety of a species not originally from North America.

Nagoya Purple Kale is a fine choice for the garden, but it is also a good selection for planting in outdoor pots and containers. It is often used as a 'filler' in the 'spiller-thriller-filler' container combination, providing a canvas of foliage against which the thriller plants stand out. Note that when growing plants in outdoor containers and baskets, they may require more frequent waterings than they would in the yard or garden.
