### Miniature Jade Plant

*Crassula ovata 'Minor'*

Height: 30 inches

Spread: 20 inches

Other Names: Baby Jade, Money Plant, Crassula ovata Minima

#### Description:

An elegantly branched miniature variety with small, attractive, emerald green succulent foliage; coral pink flower clusters in late winter when exposed to full sun; very slow growing; perfect for mixed containers in bright indoor areas

#### Features & Attributes

Miniature Jade Plant features showy clusters of coral-pink star-shaped flowers with pink overtones at the ends of the branches in late winter. The flowers are excellent for cutting. Its attractive succulent round leaves emerge chartreuse, turning dark green in color with distinctive crimson edges throughout the year.

This is a multi-stemmed evergreen houseplant with an upright spreading habit of growth. This plant can be pruned at any time to keep it looking its best.

#### Planting & Growing

When grown indoors, Miniature Jade Plant can be expected to grow to be about 30 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 20 inches. It grows at a slow rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 15 years. This houseplant will do well in a location that gets either direct or indirect sunlight, although it will usually require a more brightly-lit environment than what artificial indoor lighting alone can provide. It prefers dry to average moisture levels with very well-drained soil, and may die if left in standing water for any length of time. This plant should be watered when the surface of the soil gets dry, and will need watering approximately once each week. Be aware that your particular watering schedule may vary depending on its location in the room, the pot size, plant size and other conditions; if in doubt, ask one of our experts in the store for advice. Like most succulents and cacti, it prefers to grow in poor soils and should therefore never be fertilized. It is not particular as to soil pH, but grows best in sandy soil. Contact the store for specific recommendations on pre-mixed potting soil for this plant. Be warned that parts of this plant are known to be toxic to humans and animals, so special care should be exercised if growing it around children and pets.
